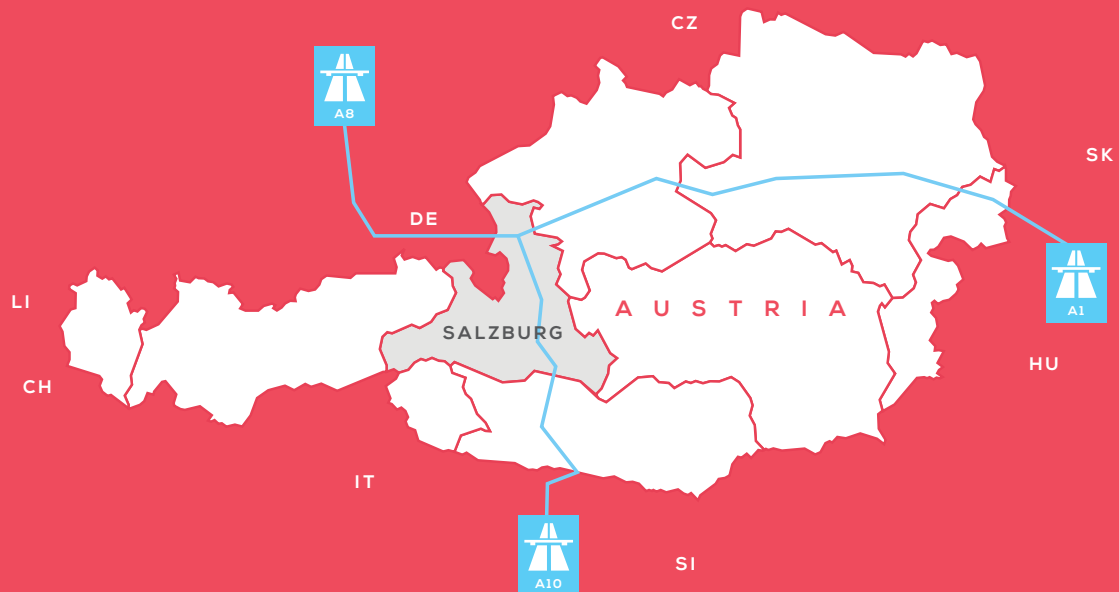

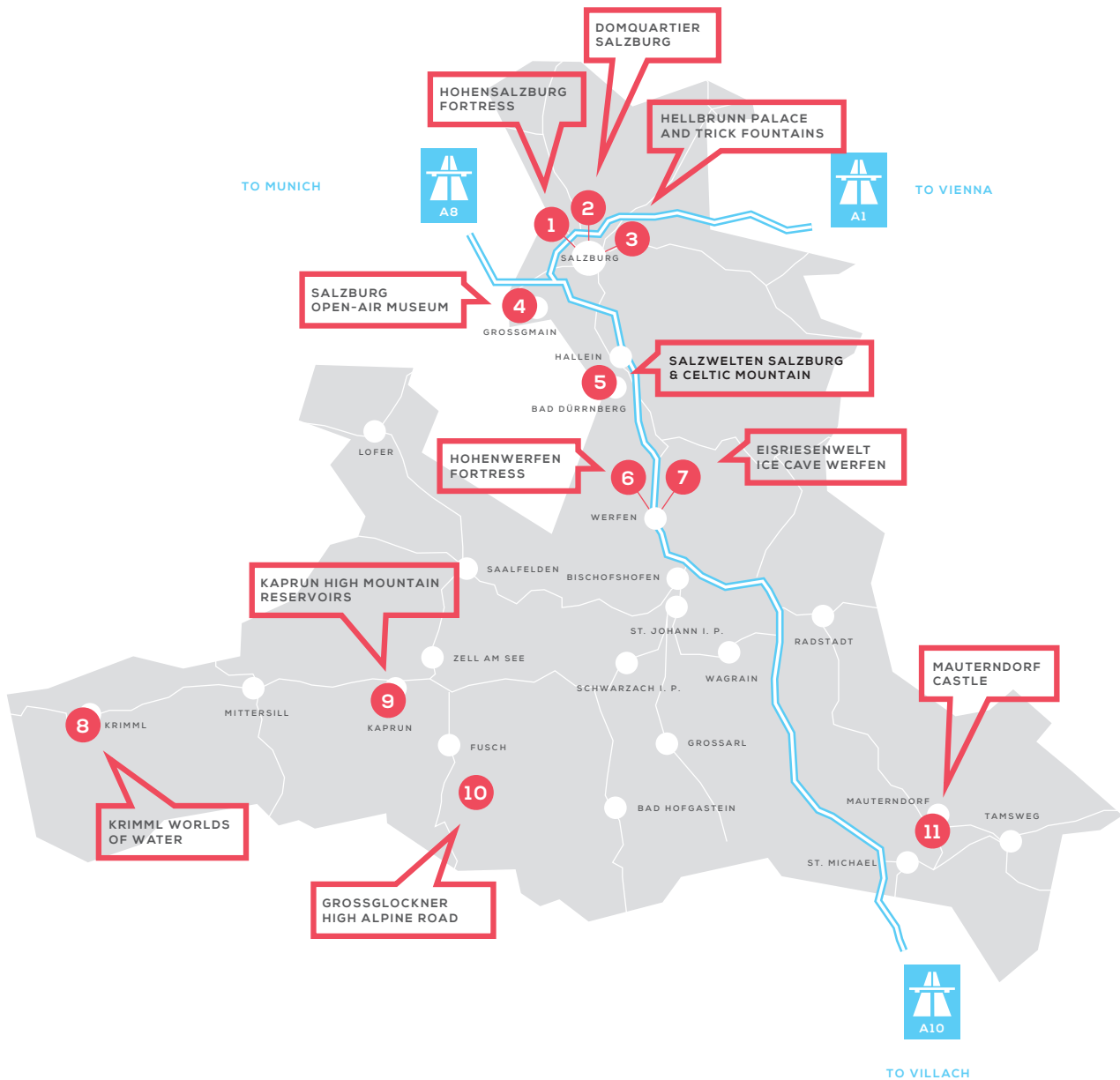

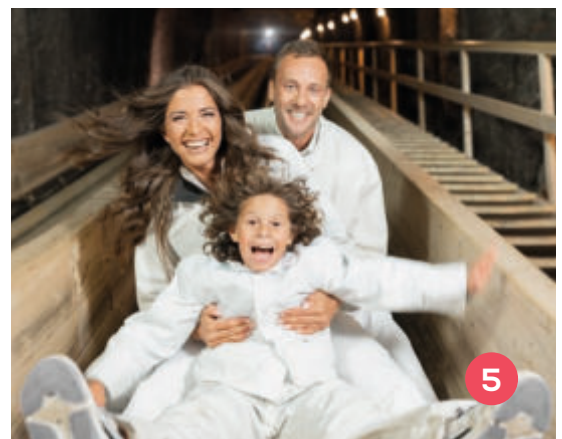

### MODULE F Observation tower and Salzburg Bull

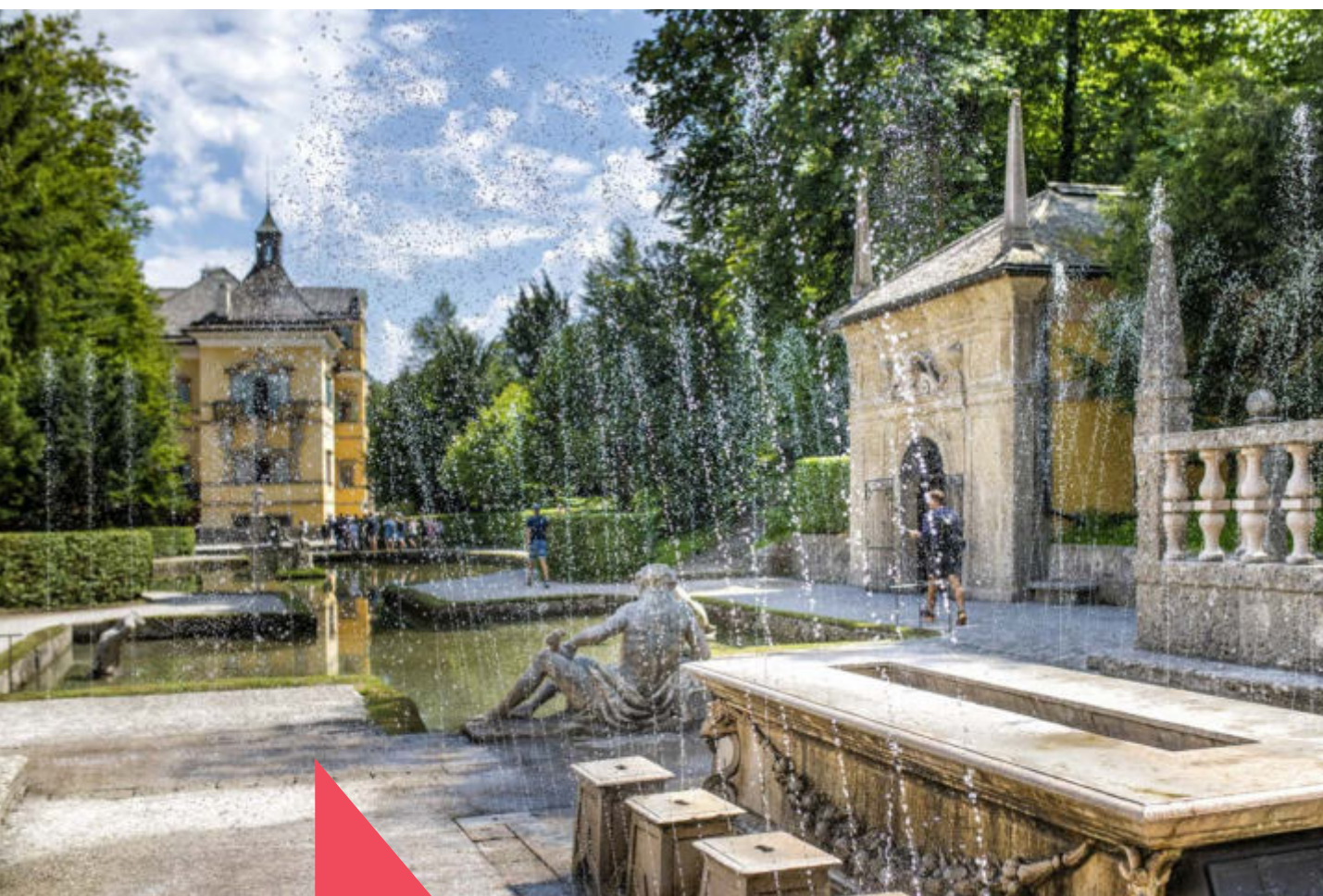

## **FARMING LIFE IN YEARS GONE BY**

A visit to the museum is like a journey through six centuries of life in the Province of Salzburg. Over one hundred original artefacts and buildings from all over the Province of Salzburg have been faithfully reassembled and furnished, including farmhouses and farmyards, mountain huts, blacksmiths workshops, mills, electric generators, creameries, breweries and many more. The oldest buildings date back to the 15th century. All the buildings are set in a natural environment and connected by a network of romantic walking paths.

## **MUSEUM RAILWAY, INN**

A 2 km narrow-gauge railway winds its way around the 50 hectares of the open air museum and runs the whole day (included in admission price). The museum train ride provides visitors with numerous interesting views of the museum grounds and the various buildings. There are 3 station stops around the grounds. Your physical well-being will also be catered to. The cosy museum inn with its large outdoor dining area is centrally located on the museum grounds and even has its own train stop!



## **FARM GARDENS, NATURAL KNEIPP FOOTBATH, VINTAGE TRACTORS**

The eleven farm gardens cultivated by the museum gardeners are a pleasure to behold – with typical herbs, flowers and vegetables cultivated as they were in the past. Guests can cool off in the wonderful natural Kneipp footbaths. Exhibitions on several themes and an interactive vintage tractor show highlight various aspects of farming history in Salzburg.

## DURATION

The mine can only be visited on a guided tour, which lasts around 90 minutes. Standard tours are available in German and English, and we have audio guides in 15 languages. You can explore the Celtic Mountain afterwards (you should allow around 30–60 minutes for this).

## ARRIVAL

Salzwelten Salzburg is situated in the town of Hallein, just 30 kilometres from Salzburg city centre.

## LET’S GO UNDERGROUND

The mine train takes you deep into the Dürrenberg on an exciting journey through time: from modern mining and salt production back to the Celtic miners’ era, via the magnificent Baroque period and the dark Middle Ages. Swift wooden slides and a wide network of winding tunnels ensure action abounds. The raft trip across the mystical salt lake takes you into the dazzling world of baroque Salzburg. And along the way, you’ll cross the only underground border between Austria and Germany.

## SALT MANUFACTORY EXPERIENCE

At the Celtic Mountain, a modern showcase saltworks has been built in place of the old “Solestube”. Here you can see for yourself how premium-quality, hand-scooped BAD ISCHLER gourmet salt is made from Dürrenberg’s natural brine. Watch over the master salt maker’s shoulder as he goes about his work.



## ARCHAEOLOGICAL EXCAVATIONS

Large parts of the Dürrenberg were populated as early as 600 BC. Mining and trading the “white gold” brought great prosperity to these people during the Iron Age. To date, around 400 graves and many remnants from the settlements have been excavated. Rich grave finds, such as the famous beaked jug, gold jewellery, weapons and everyday objects, are now on display at the Hallein Celtic Museum.

## SALINA CELTIC VILLAGE

Take a walk around the reconstructed SALINA Celtic Village and get a feel for how the Celts lived 2500 years ago. In close cooperation with the Hallein Celtic Museum, the small village on the Dürrenberg has been built based on the latest scientific findings and made accessible to the public. It brings a bygone era back to life. The SALINA Celtic Village, the new salt manufactory and the themed playground are best explored interactively with the Salzwelten app, which features virtual adventure games and an augmented reality (AR) function.

### PHYSICAL DEMANDS

Unfortunately, the natural conditions on the mountain are not suitable for prams or wheelchairs. Children are allowed to visit the mine from the age of 4 years. The tour involves a walk of about 1 km. Sturdy shoes and warm clothes are recommended; the temperature underground is approximately 10°C.

Personal tours provide visitors with deep insights into the eventful history of Hohenwerfen castle. One highlight of the visit is the demonstration of how to handle birds of prey staged by the historical "Landesfalkenhof".

Schinder Bärbel, mother of "Jackl the Sorcerer", was suspected of being a witch, persecuted and imprisoned and also tells her story.

## LARGEST ICE CAVE IN THE WORLD

This cave system was created by water flowing under the ground millions of years ago and later conquered by ice. It is unique the world over in every respect.

## FACTS, FIGURES AND ITEMS OF INTEREST

Giant chambers alternate with narrow passageways, small figures of ice with powerful sculptures of gigantic proportions. Water from thawing ice drips down in the spring, only to freeze in the cave and remain frozen, even at the height of summer. Almost the entire area on the tour is covered in ice.

- 40-kilometer cave system – 1 km open to visitors
- Tour with carbide lamps and extra-bright magnesium light
- Cave temperature 0°C – warm clothing and sturdy footwear recommended
- 20-minute walk from the visitor center to the base station for the cable car
- Ride on one of Austria's steepest cable cars
- Another 20-minute walk to the immense cave entrance at 1642 meters above sea level
- There is an altitude change of 134 meters (1400 steps) within the cavern
- All paths are secured by guardrails.
- Not suitable for the physically disabled or the frail!

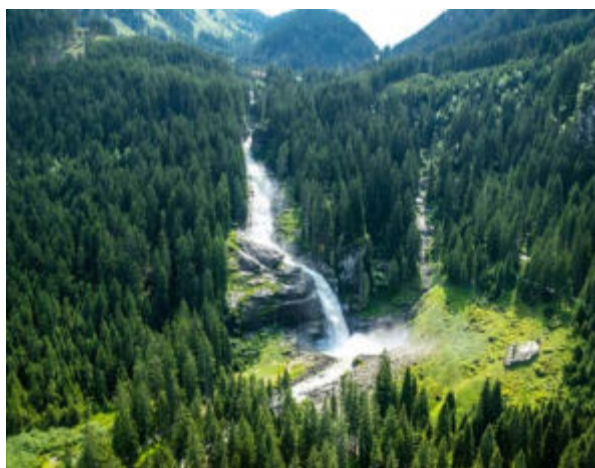

## WATERFALL CENTER

An ideal starting point for a visit to the Krimml Waterfalls is the modern Krimml Worlds of Water. This innovative adventure center is a combination of educational entertainment, sensory experience and active participation.

## AQUASZENARIUM - A JOURNEY INTO THE WATERFALL

The heart of the Water Worlds is the modern Waterfall Center: The Aquaszenarium is a projection show that is unique in Austria and a blast for all ages. Recorded projections play on the floor and walls and can be influenced and changed by touch or footstep. This multimedia device immerses visitors in various playful water worlds: It starts with the wetlands at the upper falls of the Krimmler Ache, in which projected butterflies, grasses and fish can be played with interactively. It continues to a water level, where visitors seem to stand in the middle of the waterfall and can reach through the waterfall to grab apparent treasures. Then it goes down into the underwater world, in which the visitor is optically reduced to the size of microbes.

In the exhibition area "House of Water" it's all about the transfer of knowledge: The "Faces of Water" exhibition takes visitors on a fantastic journey to discover water in all its forms. On a tour, visitors will feel with all their senses the various paths that water takes on our planet. Outside, visitors are encouraged to become active: There is a water-animated figure "AquaMax", an aquatic version of table football, and much more...

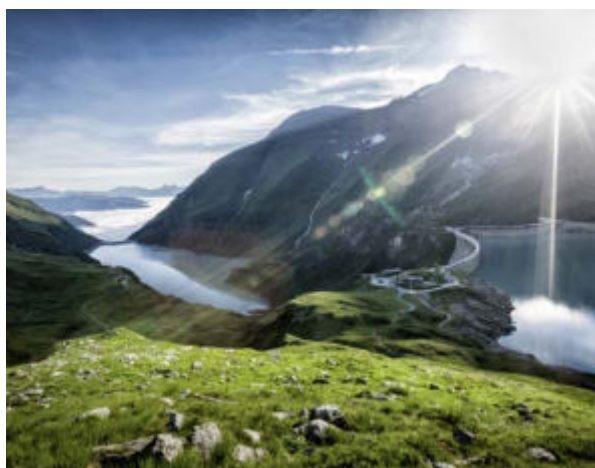
